SEC SECRETS raced behind the leaders in the middle of the pack, made a late bid. LADY MINISTER saved ground near the back, waited in the turn, lacked running room, angled out, rallied down the stretch after moving to the rail. BOLD LOUISA outrun early, late gain. LOOKIN LUCKY even effort. FIRE E KATE never close. GOLDEN SLIVER showed little. SUPER BONUS early factor, dropped back. OVERCLAS vied for the lead, stopped.
