RIGHT REVVED pressed the pace on the inside, took command and won easily. CLEAT vied for the lead at the beginning, eased back, came around the final turn on the rail, made a late inside bid. CHIEF THREE SOX raced in the middle of the field early, came around the final turn four wide and finished willingly. WORLDLY WAYS (GB) reserved near the back in the beginning, moved up, but lacked a late rally. GROOVIN saved ground near the back, improved position, but was no factor. HEZA FAST TAB void of early speed, came around the second turn five wide and proved no threat. CHARLEY GUNN raced in the back in the early going, came around the final turn five wide and showed little. DIGNITAS DANCER broke in at the start, vied for the lead, came around the second turn six wide, while retreating. STRATUS pressed the early pace, stopped.
