DIXIE DOT COM raced within contention, moved up on the outside around the final turn, took command, pulled away and was much the best today. MR ROSS lacked early speed, came around the second turn on the outside, made a bid, proved no match for the winner, but was clearly second. FIVE STRAIGHT hopped out at the break, then raced near the back in the early going, moved up on the outside around the final turn and made a mild bid, but was no match for the top two. WOODEN PHONE vied for the early lead, dueling with HAL'S HOPE, saved ground in the early going and tired around the final turn. CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN raced in the middle of the field in the early going, angled to the rail, while racing rank and lacked a late rally. HAL'S HOPE dueled for the early advantage, racing outside of WOODEN PHONE and was done early. DOCTOR MIKE always raced near the back and showed little.
