STAKES Irving Distaff S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$9,600 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$400 to pass the entry box and an additional \$400 to start with \$60,000 guaranteed of which \$36,000 to the owner of the winner, \$12,000 to second, \$6,600 to third, \$3,600 to fourth and \$1,800 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 114 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2007 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 twice in 2007, 5 lbs.; \$18,000 in 2006-2007, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to benamed through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2006-2007 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, April 19, 2007 with 45 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.) (Rail at 20 feet).

Footnotes

CAROLINA SKY contested the pace on the inside, dropped back a bit near the half-mile pole, re-engaged the leader on the far turn, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under vigorous right hand urging. MY THREE SISTERS settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, rallied near the furlong marker and closed fast to just miss. NOT IN MY HOUSE was well placed on the inside, moved off the rail near the quarter-pole, shifted out in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled determinedly in the final furlong but missed. D FINE OKIE was allowed to settle into stride, raced three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, moved into a good striking position in upper stretch but lacked the needed kick. GOTTAH PENNY was very washy in the warm-up, settled off the pace while off the rail, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed kick. HOMEMAKER settled towards the rear of the field, raced between rivals on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and improved position. JUBILEE contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. PALACE RUMOR broke a bit slow,

lagged at the rear of the field, swung out leaving the far turn and failed to threaten. CROSS raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was hard ridden while four then five wide on the far turn and came up empty. WILD ENCOUNTER settled towards the back while saving ground, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch and was no factor. FAIRWELL MADRID raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased the leaders on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and dropped out. (Rail at 20 Feet)
