CALOOSAHATCHEE settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and closed fast to get up at the wire. P. S. I LOVE YOU was reserved off the early pace, moved up late on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, dueled gamely in the stretch and was denied at the wire. JILL MARIE settled near the back of the field while off the rail, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied in the center of the course and closed strongly to just miss in a blanket finish. SERA'S TUNNEL tracked the leader on the outside, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled gamely in the stretch but missed. BELLA BUBBLES set the clear pace on the inside, was challenged on the far turn, dueled in the stretch and also missed. PURE RED HEAD settled off the pace while off the rail, moved closer late on the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. DIXIE DUST raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the

outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. NEWYEARS EVE brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved up late on the backstretch, chased four wide on the far turn and came up empty. SMOOTH SEA brushed with a rival at the start then was taken back, lagged near the back and showed little. ABBY THE GREAT lagged at the rear of the field and was outrun. (Rail at 20 Feet)
