PATTY'S PRIDE lagged well behind while saving ground, moved off the rail near the quarter-pole, shifted out in upper stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. STANDBYYOURMANGIRL was taken back nearing the first turn then rated off the pace, settled a bit on the backstretch, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole and was caught late. TICKLEYOURFANCY raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. THE CAT WHO contested the pace on the outside, vied into upper stretch then gave way. GUANABARA GAL saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was ridden along on the far turn and failed to threaten. IN THE BAND raced three wide on the first turn, settled in third position, moved up near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three wide on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch and came up empty. BADNESS contested the pace on the inside, dropped out near the quarter-pole and tired. (Rail at 20 Feet)
