Footnotes

TIZ BIZ was well placed just off the pace, waited while inside on the far turn, took advantage of a rail opening at the top of the stretch, made a bid on the inside, edged clear inside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. THEZIMMAN was off two lengths behind the field, lingered at the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy for the place. HUNTERWOOD POINT brushed with a rival at the start, settled while off the inside, was blocked from the quarter-pole to the furlong marker, moved to the outside for room and finished well but was too late. ROAD HAWK set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, led into the final furlong but was outfinished. MASTER JEHU brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turns and lacked the needed response. JACKRABBIT FAST went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, brushed with a rival near the furlong marker and weakened. GOLD DELTA was restless in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased on the far turn, brushed with JACKRABBIT FAST near the furlong marker and tired. THUNDER BRITCHES went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. (Rail at 20 Feet)
