TOUCH TONE LILLY was urged along while just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, made a rail bid passing the quarter-pole, battled with NAUGHTY NAUGHTY into the final furlong then edged clear under strong right hand urging. NAUGHTY NAUGHTY broke outward at the start, pressed the pace, vied three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. B G GOLDEN TIME was ridden along while off the pace, moved off the rail on the turn, dropped back in entering the stretch and failed to rally while best of the rest. UP FOR THE FIGHT broke outward at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied four wide on the turn and tired. SOPHISTICATED GAL raced towards the rear of the field, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CHINESE ART set the pace under pressure, lugged out a bit on the turn and gave way. WESTWARD WIND dropped back while urged along, lugged out a bit on the turn and failed to respond. CLOSET RUMORS broke in the air and was off slow, raced three to four wide on the turn and was no factor.
