Footnotes

MAMBO AGAIN broke outward at the start, chased the pace on the outside, vied four wide on the turn, battled with WEE BE GONE into the final furlong then edged clear under strong right hand urging. WEE BE GONE bumped with a rival at the start, was rated just off the pace, engaged the leaders leaving the backstretch, vied three wide on the turn, battled with the winner into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. PRECOCIOUS ZAK broke a bit slow, was ridden along at the rear of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. GENTLE FLYER broke inward and bobbed then bumped with a rival, moved in while rated just off the pace, waited behind a wall of horses on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved in inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. CARLISLES JET dueled for the lead, vied into the stretch and tired. GUACAMOLE dueled on the inside, vied into the stretch and weakened.
