Footnotes

CHARLIE TUNA set the pace under some pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, maintained a clear advantage into the final furlong and just held under right hand urging. WAR WHOOP settled at the back of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to five wide passing the quarter-pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to just miss. KING'S RACE settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while able to garner the show. SHINING VALUE tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn and weakened. BETCHO settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the turn and came up empty. EVE N TOUCH pressed the pace while in hand, drew even near the half-mile pole, vied three wide on the turn and gave way.
