Footnotes

MALTESE DOG was last away, raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, inched closer while four to five wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch and edged clear under steady handling. MITHRANDIR (CHI) raced four wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the well bunched field, was urged along on the far turn, shifted four wide inside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. VALID PERFORMANCE was caught five wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and weakened then was caught for the place late. PERFECT LOU raced five wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and tired. TURNLEFTATTHELIGHT was well placed just off the pace while off the rail, bided his time on the far turn, shifted over heels coming to the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. DANCIT raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn and gave way. CURRAGH MON was in a bit tight early on the first turn, raced four wide on that turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. NEON BULLET was rated just behind the leaders on the inside, chased while continuing to save ground on the far turn and dropped out. ONE TOUGH BUCK raced four wide on the first turn, was in tight and dropped back early on the backstretch, settled on the outside, went four then five wide on the far turn and had nothing left.
