CHINDI outrun in the early part, made a late gain. WHATAFLASHYACTOR outside speed, weakened. BEST DRESSED TRUCK got off to a slow start, moved up then flattened out. BEVERLY GREEDY steadied early, getting in tight quarters, rushed up then faltered. HEZA FAST TAB wide turn, no factor. SMILING PRINCE was outrun. .
