MT. OREAD chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole and drew away under strong right hand urging. IKANTOO broke a bit slow, rushed up on the inside, was shuffled back entering the turn, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and secured the place while unable to threaten the winner. REGENT OF RED BIRD was away awkwardly, chased the pace through the turn and weakened while able to hold the show. KASH KITTY bumped with a rival at the start, sped clear and dictated terms, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired. TOPOKYA was ridden along towards the rear, came three wide into the stretch and improved position. IZ was ridden along towards the outside, raced four wide early on the turn then shifted in, dropped to the rail near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. CATAPULT SHOT was in tight leaving the chute, raced three wide on the turn and showed little. SNICKER M H F was hard ridden in the middle of the field, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. BAMA SLEW was in tight leaving the chute, raced off the pace while hard ridden, went four wide on the turn and faltered. N HIS HANDS bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along between rivals and retreated. STINGEREE broke very awkwardly and quickly dropped back then trailed throughout.
