Footnotes

HOLY HUMOR was rank while three wide on the first turn, raced off the pace, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. ACTUAL FACT broke out sharply at the start and bumped with a rival, was unhurried towards the rear, moved closer on the far turn, shifted over heels passing the quarter-pole, came between rivals at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly but missed. INDY EXPRESS settled towards the front of the field, moved up while three to four wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong but was overtaken. QUACK IN THE WALL settled in third, chased on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. LANG HEART broke outward at the start, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and lacked the needed response. REAGAN JAMES raced four wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went five wide on the far turn and failed to rally. RED RIVER KING bumped with a rival at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. TEXAS GRAN ZAR broke outward and bumped with a rival, set the pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. EL TAPIDERO bumped with a rival at the start, raced four to five wide on the far turn and was no factor. ANACONDA bumped with a rival at the start, chased the leader into the far turn and faded. LARRY'S BLUESECRET broke outward at the start, was a bit rank on the first turn and dropped out after a half-mile. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP was off slow, drifted six wide on the first turn and was pulled up but walked off. (Rail at 0 Feet)
