**Footnotes**

WINCHESTER BAY was well rated while setting the pace, responded well to the challenge of LOVE LIBERTY and held gamely under strong urging. LOVE LIBERTY tracked the pace, made a bid nearing the quarter-pole, battled with the winner in the stretch and was outfinished while able to get the place. JOHN MEDICA was rank on the first turn then rated off the pace, chased the leader on the far turn and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. IMACROOK was reserved off the pace, lacked room on the far turn and finished willingly. SEFAPIANO JR. settled towards the rear of the field, raced three to four wide on the far turn, jostled with a rival while five wide into the stretch and also finished willingly. BILLIE BLUE settled on the inside, moved out at the top of the stretch, drifted out and bothered NASHEET near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. NASHEET raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, jostled with a rival while four wide into the stretch, was shut-off and taken up a bit near the furlong marker then also lacked the needed response. COLOSSAL FIRE was last away, raced four wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside, chased on the far turn and faded. GOLDEN CHAPEL raced three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, went four wide early on the far turn, dropped to the inside and was no factor. (Rail at 10 Feet)
