BIG MEANY was unhurried from the start, started to advance with a half mile to run, made a bid entering the stretch, drew even with DREAM TRIPPER near the sixteenth marker, and edged clear under right hand urging. DREAM TRIPPER crossed over after the start, set all of the pace, was headed near the sixteenth pole, and gave way. CASTNER stalked the pace through the backstretch, dropped back a bit on the final turn, and finished willingly in the stretch drive. ALY VICTORY was off slowly, raced well back into the stretch, and improved position. POWER GLIDE was forwardly placed from the start, vied into the stretch, and weakened. WINGS OF OISIN raced towards the rear, and failed to rally. STEALING HEAVEN raced near the back, and showed little. SUNNY'S BOLD HALO raced in the middle of the field, was roused with three furlongs to run, but failed to respond. ADMIRAL DEWEY was through after a half mile, and stopped.
