SWAINS NEWS was well placed behind the leaders, chased three wide on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under good handling. WAUPACA settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, rallied on the rail entering the final furlong and secured the place while unable to match the winner. GENERAL CHARLEY contested the pace on the inside, kicked clear leaving the far turn, remained clear into the final furlong but was overtaken then missed the place. HAXTUN'S HUSTLER was in a bit tight at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. C'MON TIGER contested the pace on the outside, dropped out leaving the far turn and gave way. MR. UNSTOPPABLE raced three wide on the first turn, was urged along on the outside and failed to respond. TAKSENT settled off the pace, dropped well behind the field and showed little. (Rail at 0 Feet)
