FORTUNATE JONES was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. EXPECT SMOKE was hustled from the start, pressed the pace between rivals, chased while off the rail on the turn and finished willingly for the place. BELTON set the the pace under pressure, edged clear leaving the backstretch, was collared inside the furlong marker and weakened. STONE COLD KITTY chased the pace between rivals, bumped with TEXAS TALL TALE near the half-mile pole, raced four then three wide on the turn, was in tight near the sixteenth-pole and also weakened. BELOW broke outward and bumped with a rival, chased the pace, raced five wide on the turn, dropped to three wide near the quarter-pole and tired. SO SENECA pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back while in a bit tight on the turn and came up empty. KRISTYS DOVE HUNT bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, shifted four wide near the guarter-pole and failed to respond. MR. DOUG MAGEE stumbled at the start, saved ground at the rear of the field and was no factor. TEXAS TALL TALE chased the pace, bumped with STONE COLD KITTY near the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn and faded.
