LADITUDE broke outward and bumped with a rival, was hustled into the first turn, set the pace while off the rail, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under left hand urging. TWO JAYS SECRET hopped slightly at the start, raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was well placed behind the leading group, ranged up while saving ground on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled with LADITUDE in the stretch and missed. WACO HUG broke outward at the start, angled in before the first turn, lagged well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn finished well but was too late. OH SO AWESOME raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. GODOWNSWINGING was in tight at the start, dropped well off the pace, raced three to four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. WIND SOCK raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, went three to four wide on the far turn and faded. HADACURE bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
