CHIEF OF AFFAIRS sped to the lead, dictated terms through the turn and drew off while ridden out. SOUTHERN VINTAGE chased the pace, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and secured the place while no match for the winner. BOLD MINARDI chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and tired. DURTY WHIT broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field, went three to four wide on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. PRISCILLA'S BOY was void of speed, raced four then five wide on the turn and also improved position. VALID ID. chased the pace, saved ground on the turn and tired. EL D hesitated at the start, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. COAHUILA was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn and failed to respond. CAMPFIRE COFFEE chased the pace between rivals, raced three to four wide on the turn and faded. MEXICAN STORM was ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. TEXAS BOBCAT dropped back while hard ridden, raced three wide on the turn and was outrun. TEXAS JET chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and stopped. NOTORIOUS CAT bumped with a rival at the start, moved up on the inside, was in tight near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and faltered.
