**Footnotes**

RED THUNDER was well rated while off the rail, drifted in a bit near the furlong marker and edged clear under steady urging. SNOW DRIFT broke outward and bumped with a rival, was rated while a bit rank, saved ground on the far turn, made a mild bid near the furlong marker then was outfinished but continued willingly to get the place. WINCHESTER BAY was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened while clear for the show. WALKWAY broke outward and a bit slow, raced four wide on the first turn, moved up to race up close to the pace, chased the winner on the far turn and tired. BIG YARD BIRD was bumped on both sides at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. ALBERT W. raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. AUMERLE bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on both turns and also failed to respond. MAD AT CHA lingered well back in the field, dropped further back near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide approaching the quarter-pole and was no factor. STORMINTOTHEFRONT bumped with a rival after the start and was through after a half-mile.
