Footnotes

REAL FAST bumped hard with a rival at the start, was well placed just behind the leader, waited while saving ground on the turn, rallied inside entering the final furlong, closed gamely on the inside and prevailed under good handling. SWEET LITTLE CAT set the pace while off the rail, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led into the final furlong but was caught. BETA BELIEVE bobbed ever so slightly at the start then bumped with a rival, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened while able to hold the show. IM YOUR DEVIL broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced between rivals, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. JAZZY FLYER came in at the start and bumped hard with a rival, was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. PEPPERITA was off slow, raced at the rear of the field and failed to threaten. RIVERSIDE PARADE was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and retreated.
