GO FOR DOUGH was unhurried towards the rear of the field, moved up on the inside near the seven-sixteenths pole, ranged up on the far turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch and drew clear under strong handling. CHANDAS raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, made a bid with three furlongs to run, vied into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. GO MR. MACK was hustled from the start then well placed just off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and tired while just able to get the show. LOU'S LITTLELIVELY raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. MILAGROSO set the clear pace, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. TAPPYHOUR lingered well back in the field, raced four wide on the far turn and was no factor. DOT'S TWO SOCKS settled in the middle of the field, saved ground on the turns and also failed to respond. POINT OF GREATNESS was off slow and trailed throughout.
