Footnotes

BEAR BOTTOM leaned out at the start, was rated while off the rail on the first turn, continued under some restraint on the backstretch, dropped to the inside midway through the far turn, shifted back off the rail late on that bend, chased the leader in upper stretch, pursued that rival in the final furlong and got up late under strong urging. ROYAL CHA CHA went three to four wide on the first turn, was forced out early on the backstretch, raced just off the pace, made a bid while four wide early on the far turn, dropped to three wide near the quarter-pole, moved to one off the rail at the top of the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. SWAMP LAST CHANCE went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, was in tight near the five-sixteenths pole and weakened while able to get the show. GLORIOUS DEVON was hustled from the start, set the pace, lost the lead near the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. COOKIN GONE BAD was rank while hard held along the rail on the first turn, raced with her head cocked to the side on the backstretch, was taken up while lugging out at the three-eighths pole and came up empty.
