Footnotes

BIEN NICOLE tracked the pace while three wide, drew even entering the final turn, inched clear in upper stretch, responded when challenged by CALMA PRADO inside the eighth pole, and prevailed under strong urging. CALMA PRADO was allowed to settle into stride, ranged up on the final turn, angled four wide entering the stretch, engaged the winner in the final furlong, but was turned away. EL PORTAL raced off the pace early, advanced on the rail past the half mile pole, loomed a threat entering the stretch, but lacked the needed response. NELL'S NINER was well placed through the final turn, angled five wide entering the stretch, and failed to respond. LISA'S APPROVAL trailed the field early, ranged up on the second turn, but failed to rally. SUNNY SCARLETT pressed the pace, drew even with the leader entering the final turn, vied into the stretch, and weakened. KISSIN CHARM raced up close, and was through after a half mile. MANCHESHOT raced four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, and never reached contention. KENZIE GIRL set a pressured pace, vied into the stretch, and faded. TRICKSAND was always outrun.
