Footnotes

STOP TALKING settled off the pace, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, went two then three wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead approaching the three-sixteenths pole and drew away under strong handling. PATRICK'S JOY settled on the inside, was ridden along on the far turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. MORAVIAN PRINCE bumped hard with rivals at the start, settled towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn and secured the show. LE FLYING MONKEY bumped hard with MORAVIAN PRINCE at the start, lagged well behind while inside on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, went four wide on the far turn and improved position. ANEW RUMOR shifted three wide late on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, raced off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and also improved position. ARTILLERY moved in early, settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, made his way through traffic inside the furlong marker and also failed to threaten. THISCATSATALKIN was fractious in the gate, broke in the air then bumped with a rival but broke with the field, settled well off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and was no factor. RICH MONARCHOS raced towards the front of the field while off the rail and failed to rally. LOOZIANA BOY was in tight while inside late on the first turn, raced near the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and also failed to rally. MASON LANE was last away, raced towards the front, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied three then two wide on the far turn and gave way. BIG DRIVE raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace and failed to respond. LEGS ON FIRE broke in at the start, set the clear pace, was challenged leaving the backstretch, vied into the stretch and stopped. (Rail at 0 Feet)
