C. A. D.'S COMBO settled behind the leading group, advanced while saving ground on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch, and closed with a rush to get up in the final stride. TAKE OUT THE TRASH dueled between rivals through the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, opened a commanding lead past the furlong marker, but shortened stride late and was denied. MY GAMBLIN LADY dueled for the lead while inside three rivals, vied into the stretch, and gave way. SCAT KITTY CAT dueled for three lead while four wide, vied into the stretch, and gave way. TWILIGHT PEAK was allowed to settle into stride, failed to menace the top finishers, but improved position. SINGLE PROSPECT dueled from between rivals, dropped out approaching the quarter pole, and tired in the stretch. DELIRIUM chased the dueling leaders, and failed to rally in an even effort. CREPE DA SLEW settled near mid field, raced four wide on the turn, angled five wide into the stretch, and failed to rally. JENNIFER'S REVIVAL hesitated at the start, and failed to reach contention. SHELLBY

DUXSTER settled behind the leaders, raced four wide on the turn, drifted six wide into the stretch, and faltered. STRUCK BY LUCK was reserved early, angled eight wide leaving the turn, and failed to menace. ALLEY GAL raced towards the rear, angled six wide entering the stretch, and failed to threaten. BBOP DANCER saved ground to no avail, and was not urged late. LIPLOCK was void of early speed, angled ten wide entering the stretch, and was always outrun.
