SEEKING WEST was well rated while setting the pace, extended the advantage on the far turn, held a clear lead into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. LIME RICKEY broke a bit slow, went four wide on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, tracked the leader, chased three then two wide on the far turn, pursued the winner in the stretch and was second best. BAYBOY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. DUAL FORECAST settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, came off the rail near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) was reserved at the back, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. B G ROYAL WEST was reserved while off the inside, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 0 Feet)
