Footnotes

I NEED A BALEOUT settled towards the rear, waited patiently on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, squeezed between rivals, came three wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up near the wire. CASHINMYWRANGLERS set the pace on the inside through quick fractions, extended the advantage in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught. BALTIMORE BOB tracked the pace while off the rail, came under some urging on the backstretch, chased on the far turn and lacked the needed kick while well clear for the show. SPECIAL DURBEE went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. RED BIRDS MAGICIAN settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. CATRIN broke two lengths behind the field, lagged at the rear and showed little. ZARBY'S HOME raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. (Rail at 0 Feet)
