Footnotes

TASTE OF TEXAS prompted the pace on the inside of KRIS'S IMPULSE, took the lead passing the half-mile pole, vied inside on the far turn, inched clear in upper stretch and held sway under right hand urging. PARTY LIGHTS was caught four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but was second best. JAZZ MAN raced three wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response while up for the show. WINNING FORUM settled just off the pace, was roused on the far turn and failed to rally. KRIS'S IMPULSE set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead passing the half-mile pole, vied outside on the far turn and tired. COMING THRU TEXAS raced three wide on the first turn, moved up on the backstretch, chased four wide on the far turn and had nothing left. JUST LIKE JERRY broke a bit slow, settled on the inside, steadied inside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. BRUSHWITHTHEDEVIL was well placed on the inside, lost position near the three-eighths pole and came up empty. CULVER ACADEMY was reluctant to load then awkwardly into stride, raced four wide on the first turn and was no factor. CHADAHOSKEE was off slow, raced five wide on the first turn and failed to respond. SALTY MOON raced three wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 0 Feet)
