SMOKE'N AL set the pace, was challenged on the far turn, drew clear in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. WENCESLAO (MEX) saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, waited while off the rail on the far turn, dropped in behind rivals in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SLEW BAYOU TOO went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. PARISH PAY was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turns and came up empty. REAL TRICK raced two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along on the far turn and tired. RUNAWAY CRYPTO was hustled from the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, went four then five wide on the far turn and came up empty. CHIEF REDSTONE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. GOLDBIRD settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and failed to rally. KOOL SOLDIER went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and capitulated. BROOKS OPEN GOLD settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came off the rail inside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. WHEN SECONDS COUNT lagged at the rear and showed little. (Rail at
