TWILIGHT BAY was reserved off the pace while a bit off the rail, bided his time on the far turn, moved out and was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. ROYAL AGO was well placed on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the place at the wire. SCRAPPY ROO set the pace through sluggish fractions, was asked for his best in upper stretch, inched clear inside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken then caught for the place at the wire. DEPUTIFORMER was rated while three wide on the first turn, moved up to contest the lead with five furlongs to run, vied outside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong then weakened. RED ROCK CREEK was unhurried near the back while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. DUAL FORECAST settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to threaten. BADGER BO tracked the pace, chased on the far turn and gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
