COUGAR HOLLOW broke out at the start, showed good speed then chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, kicked clear shortly thereafter and held well under strong urging. RAIN LIKE NO OTHER was urged along in the front half of the field, raced just off the rail on the turn, shifted three wide inside the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch and finished willingly while second best. JONESICULA was urged along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, shifted out at the top of the stretch and secured the show. ABBIE'S ON FIRE was hustled from the start, moved up to take the lead, raced inside on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. THAT'S OUR ROMEO showed good speed then chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and weakened. CATCHMEIFUCAN was reluctant to load, steadied after the start, was urged along towards the rear, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. MERCY CITY was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. HEAVENLY BROTHER was ridden along towards the back, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to respond. SPINSTOPSHERE was urged along in the back half of the field, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. TROPHY CASE broke a bit slow, moved up while ridden along, raced four then three wide on the turn and had nothing left. BROOKS OPEN GOLD dropped back while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and was outrun.
