SINNERS ANGEL lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer late on the backstretch, raced three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker and drew clear under strong urging. SAL'S BIG EASY bumped with a rival at the start, settled in the second flight, came under urging while off the rail early on the far turn, shifted five wide outside the quarter-pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and proved no match while clear for the place. THE RIGHT MOVES went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, engaged the leaders while five then four wide on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. BENCHIDY went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader leaving the backstretch, vied three then two wide on the turn and tired. ROYALTY IN EXCESS went three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight, made a bid while four then three wide on the turn but came up empty. MR. DUBAI went four wide on the first turn, settled near the back, went three wide early on the far turn then shifted five wide, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. ECONOMIC RECOVERY saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn, drifted in near the furlong marker and also came up empty. BAYOU COWBOY bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace on the inside, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
