COOK'S NOOK showed good speed then pressed the leader, drew even with that rival passing the quarter-pole, dueled into the final furlong, inched clear near the sixteenth-pole and held sway under strong urging. ROAD MAP was urged along while off the pace, raced five wide on the turn, closed well to loom a threat into the final furlong and finished willingly but was second best. ALMOST LEGENDARY settled off the pace, was urged some while three then four wide on the turn, drafted behind rivals outside the three-sixteenths pole, was asked in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. EARLY DANCER chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and weakened. CASHINMYWRANGLERS chased the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and tired. ROWDY PROFIT showed good speed and set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn and gave way. TRAFFIC COMMAND broke a bit awkwardly, lacked speed on the outside, raced six wide on the turn and failed to rally. TYLER ROSEMAN chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. BULLETT BLAKE chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and capitulated. WHIZVILLE was urged along while just off the pace, dropped back while four wide on the turn and stopped.
