Footnotes

BRENDYN JO came out at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail near the three-quarter pole, threw his head while rank early on the backstretch, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, gained the lead passing the quarter-pole and drew away under strong urging. PEACEFUL PROSPECT raced three wide on the first turn, dropped back entering the backstretch, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn and secured the place while unable to match the winner. WACO HUG settled on the inside, moved closer on the far turn but came up empty while best of the rest. TWINDIAN set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. RARE FLYER pressed the pace on the outside, vied outside of TWINDIAN on the far turn and tired. A P TEXAS drifted out after the start, settled at the back of the field, moved closer on the far turn, had the rider lose his whip near the quarter-pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch and had nothing left.
