No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$110,000 to the owner of the winner, \$38,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$11,500 to fourth, \$5,500 to fifth and \$3,000 for placing sixth through tenth. If less than ten horses start, the purse money not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weight: Colts and Geldings, 122 lbs. Fillies, 117 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. In allowance stakes, starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings at time of entry as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. The winning owner, trainer and jockey to receive a suitable award. Nominations closed Thursday, April 29, 2010 with 21 nominations.

GAME ON DUDE broke inward and brushed with a rival, settled off the pace, rallied on the far turn, made a three wide near the quarter-pole and drew clear under steady handling. CRIDER was urged along on the backstretch, advanced three wide on the far turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. HENSHIN HERO broke inward at the start, set the clear pace while off the rail, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole and tired while clear for the show. WANDO REDD was rated in the second while saving ground, dropped back on the far turn and came up empty. THATLLEAVEAMARK brushed with a rival at the start, was urged along on the backstretch and retreated. GILDED WOODMAN was in tight at the start, dropped well behind the field and trailed.
