Footnotes

UNBRIDLED'S HEART raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer on the far turn, steadied in traffic passing the quarter-pole, shifted four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead then drew clear under strong handling. MAD AT CHA lingered near the back of the field while towards the inside, moved closer on the far turn, shifted out near the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. ISLE OF MAN settled in the middle of the field, moved closer late on the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn, chased the winner into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick then was caught for the place. COL. WRIGHT was a bit rank while three wide on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, advanced near the seven-sixteenths pole, brushed with MAE B TODAY entering the far turn, made a bid while four then three wide early on that turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch but weakened and was overtaken. DOUGH DOUGH DOUGH raced three wide on the first turn, was unhurried well back in the field, moved closer on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and improved position. MAE B TODAY raced in the second flight, moved closer late on the backstretch, brushed with COL. WRIGHT entering the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. MACEDONIAN lagged well back in the field, saved ground on both turns and failed to threaten. ZONE AGAIN was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside and tired. RUNFORNAN raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four then

five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. THATLEAVEAMARK was fractious in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. TEXAS CITIZEN contested the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn and capitulated. WHOLELOTTAENERGY was off a couple of lengths slow, dropped well behind the field and trailed. (Rail at 0 Feet)
