LAHINCH went straight to the lead, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked in upper stretch, and maintained a safe advantage under left handed urging. TRICK BAG was well placed from the start, made a bid at the top of the stretch, but couldn't reach the winner. SWING LORD tracked the pace while three wide, vied into the final furlong, and weakened. CAMPAIGNER pressed the pace from between rivals, dropped back nearing the quarter pole, and finished evenly thereafter. LA PRADO raced well back in the field, went four wide on the final turn, and failed to threaten. GOLDEN SLEW raced towards the rear, went four wide on the second turn, and was always outrun. PLEASURE PIT was off slowly, and never reached contention.
