VALID STRIPES tracked the pace, took the lead midway down the backstretch, edged clear on the far turn, extended the lead in upper stretch and held under strong urging. HUNTERS RUNAWAY raced four to five wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, moved out on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed well but was too late. JUSTWILL raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, steadied a bit leaving the backstretch, hesitated in traffic nearing the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. LITTLE TALK set the pace, relinquished the lead midway down the backstretch, dropped out on the far turn and weakened. SUPREME SECRET bumped with a rival entering the first turn, lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and improved position. VALID PERFORMANCE was in tight entering the first turn, raced four wide on that turn, settled in the middle of the field, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. COME ON FLYER raced towards the front of the field, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. C H LEUTWIL bumped with a rival entering the first turn, raced three wide on that turn and failed to respond. FORMAL TONE raced five to six wide on the first turn and failed to threaten. REGATTA TONE settled off the pace, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. SWAMPMAN raced three wide on the first turn, stopped after a half-mile and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
