**Footnotes**

SNUCK BY dueled on the outside, moved clear while lugging out and three to four wide on the turn, extended the lead in upper stretch, was roused with the whip passing the sixteenth-pole and maintained a safe advantage. GLASS MACHINE broke awkwardly from the inside post, showed speed along the rail, was shuffled back near the seven-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn, was blocked passing the quarter-pole, moved out entering the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed determinedly but failed to reach the winner. MUCHO GATO was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally while best of the rest. SMOKEN SMOKE dueled on the inside, dropped back midway through the turn, chased the winner into the stretch and tired. CARLISLES JET dueled between horses, dropped back midway through the turn, chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. MR. EXCELLENT was beaten for speed, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. RIPROARIOUS broke outward and hit the gate, raced five wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole and never reached contention.
