PACHECO was urged along while off the pace, raced four then five wide on the turn, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. VOLTURI raced towards the rear, went five then six wide on the turn and finished willingly for the place. BUBBA KIP contested the pace, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the leader, made a bid entering the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the show. DEACON BOB raced towards the rear, went four then three wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed kick. U GO ROY contested the pace on the outside, raced four wide early on the turn, edged clear while off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was also outfinished. DOUGH DOUGH DOUGH settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn and also lacked the needed kick. I'M ONE KOOL DUDE showed early speed then chased, raced two to three wide on the turn and tired. GUCCI BOY dropped well behind, raced inside on the turn and was outrun. DOC R U IT was fractious in the gate, raced off the pace while urged along, saved ground on the turn and retreated.
