Footnotes

WISEMAN'S FERRY was away alertly, crossed over entering the first turn, set a clear pace while well rated into the stretch, drew clear past the furlong marker, and was never threatened. TRACEMARK was reserved near the back of the field, circled four wide on the final turn, and finished well while no threat to the winner. PEEKSKILL settled while saving ground, advanced a bit entering the final turn, continued to save ground into the stretch, lacked the needed response, but was best of the rest. WINDWARD PASSAGE settled in mid pack, saved ground through the final turn, ranged up entering the stretch,

but lacked the needed response. SMOKED EM was well placed from the start, drifted four wide entering the stretch, and failed to rally. JEREMIAH JACK raced well back in the field, swung six wide entering the stretch, and improved position. CAPPUCHINO broke outward at the start and bumped HOLDTHEHELM, stalked the pace into the stretch, and weakened. PREMEDITATION raced four wide on the first turn, settle in mid pack down the backstretch, angled in entering the final turn, and went evenly. DUSTY SPIKE raced four wide on the first turn, trailed the field down the backstretch, went six wide on the final turn, fanned eight wide entering the stretch, and failed to threaten. FORTY NINE DEEDS was unhurried near the back, remained well back into the stretch, and passed tired rivals. SCREEN IDOL was forwardly placed, raced four wide entering the backstretch, and steadily retreated after a half mile. PADLOCK prompted the pace three wide, and was through after a half mile. BAY MONSTER settled towards the back, raced four wide on the first turn, went five wide on the second turn, moved to six wide entering the stretch, and was no factor. HOLDTHEHELM was bumped at the start, settled in the second half of the field, angled in near the half mile pole, saved ground into the stretch, and stopped while not being urged in the final furlong.
