**Footnotes**

LOST AGENDA was never far back, made a middle move while four wide on the turn, gained the lead entering the stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, drifted out approaching the sixteenth marker, and held on under strong right hand urging. PRIVANO'S FIRST raced behind the leading group, came four wide leaving the turn, closed well into the final furlong, had his path taken nearing the sixteenth pole, lost momentum and angled in sharply, then couldn't fully recover. HOUSE DANCE broke inward and bumped a rival, raced well back in the field, angled out in upper stretch, and finished willingly for the show. ENGRAVED pressed the pace from between rivals, was pinched back near the quarter pole, and weakened in the stretch. SILVER PHONE showed no speed, saved ground on the turn, lacked room from the quarter pole into the stretch, and failed to reach contention. MR PATSY KELLY tracked the pace while three wide, vied into the stretch, and faded. HIGH CASCADE raced well back in the field, and showed very little. JETTA'S GOLDEN BOY raced four wide on the turn, and was always outrun. TEST OF TIME was reluctant to load, set a pressured pace, steadied leaving the turn while dropping out, and tired in the stretch. DOC'S ALLOWANCE raced up close on the inside, was blocked from the quarter pole into the stretch, and came up empty when clear. Following the race, the rider of PRIVANO'S FIRST claimed foul against the rider of LOST AGENDA for alleged interference near the sixteenth pole. Following the stewards review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
