Footnotes

ONCEAROUNDTWICE settled on the inside in the second flight, was blocked from the quarter pole to the three-sixteenths pole, split rivals inside that marker, and closed strongly to get up late. SILENT PICTURE broke inward and bumped hard with WILD TALE, contested the pace on the inside, edged clear nearing the quarter pole, widened the margin in upper stretch, held a commanding lead into the final furlong, but drifted out late and was caught. NEW YORK HARBOR contested the pace on the outside, failed to match strides with the winner entering the stretch, and weakened while able to hold the show. SAND WOLF was well placed in the second flight, came up empty leaving the far turn, and faded. RUSH AROUND was allowed to settle into stride, moved into contention on the far turn, but faltered. WALLY'S FAYGO dropped well back in the field, and showed little. WILD TALE was bumped hard after the start, dropped well behind the field, and trailed.
