WAUPACA settled on the inside, advanced on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. BREGO raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, chased the leaders on the far turn and finished willingly to get the place late. WISHINGITWAS was away awkwardly, raced three then four wide on the first turn, moved up to contest the pace midway down the backstretch, vied three wide on the far turn, led into the final furlong, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and weakened then was caught for the place. MORE THAN REGAL raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn, moved out in mid-stretch and finished willingly but reached his best stride too late. RUNAWAY CHOICE reared at the start, raced up close to the pace, moved up to contest the lead midway down the backstretch, vied between rivals on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. GOOSEY MOOSE contested the pace on the inside, vied into the final furlong and tired. NOBODYWANTMETILNOW lagged near the back of the field, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. SKIP AND GO settled near the middle of the field while off the rail, came under a ride on the far turn and failed to respond. TRIAL BY JURY was unhurried at the back of the field, saved ground on both turns and never reached contention. (Rail at 10 Feet)
