**Footnotes**

CURRAGH MON tracked the pace, made a bid midway through the far turn, battled with MR. ROAD WARRIOR in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. MR. ROAD WARRIOR was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, set the pace through moderate fractions while along the rail, battled with CURRAGH MON in the stretch and missed. MIDWAY TAP raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, advanced leaving the backstretch, chased four wide on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. LONGER THAN UNO raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. TRACK RECORD raced three then two wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and improved position. WAYLAY raced four wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. KING GULCH broke outward at the start, raced five wide on both turns, came six wide into the stretch and was no factor. AUDREY'S LAD raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved out leaving the backstretch, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. CHANDAS was hustled from the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on

the outside while under some urging, came under the whip near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. DUSTY TUNNEL raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and faded. OLD CHUNK OF COAL was hustled from the start, raced five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back while three wide on the far turn and retreated. BISCUIT SNATCHER bumped the hindquarters of MR. ROAD WARRIOR at the start, raced towards the rear while near the inside and showed little.
