Footnotes

EPIC MATCH raced three wide on the first turn, set the pace while off the rail, controlled the action while three wide on the far turn and drew clear under steady urging. CAPTAIN DUDE was last away, lagged well behind the field while on the inside, moved off the rail on the far turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the place. WHY BILL WHY went five wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and tired while able to get the show. JAKEONTHERUN raced three to four wide on the first turn, was in tight near the three-quarter pole, settled off the pace, came under urging while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. COOL'S PHIRE raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the leader, chased while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty. FILET GUMBO settled off the pace, came under urging near the half-mile pole, chased inside on the far turn and capitulated. POWERED BY CAT raced just off the pace while on the inside, was pinched back near the seven-sixteenths pole and dropped out.
