LEE'S SOUTH was coaxed along on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed strongly to get the lead just inside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under good handling. MASTER TIME brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside of a foe, vied along the rail on the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong, looked like a winner at that point but was overtaken while able to hold the place. TAMNATION leaned in a bit at the start, was urged some while racing in the second flight, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail inside the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. FIST PUMP brushed with an opponent at the start, settled at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside outside the three-sixteenths pole and also lacked the needed kick then missed the show. UNO DUCKSY brushed with a rival at the start, raced on the outside while in the second flight, went two then three wide on the turn, came between horses at the furlong marker and failed to rally. YES IT'S OK came out at the start and brushed with an opponent, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the stretch and tired.
