Footnotes

EL OSO was in tight off the heels of MCTALLAH near the half-mile pole, moved out on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, swept to the lead at the top of the stretch and drew clear under strong urging. TASTE BIG was well placed just off the pace, made a bid midway through the turn, battled into upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. MCTALLAH showed early speed, was taken back off the pace while under a very stout hold, raced under some urging on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and had nothing left while best of the rest. KATESEXPECTATIONS was forced out at the start, advanced on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the turn, vied into the stretch and weakened. EPIC MATCH was urged along while off the pace, moved out on the turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and tired. EARLY DUSK broke out and bumped with a rival then was hustled, set the pace, vied inside on the turn and gave way. EGBAR settled well back in the field, raced two then three wide on the turn, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten then had the rider lose his whip late. UBET' YAH was bumped at the start and forced out, raced in tight quarters midway down the backstretch, went three then four wide on the turn and was no factor.
